Project SELF Summer Employment in Law Firms

Since 1995, Project SELF has offered summer internships at local law firms, and other related businesses, to qualifying high school seniors from Santa Ana. Each internship lasts for eight weeks, during which interns are paid for their work. Participating law firms and businesses pay the interns' wages. Internships are made possible through our longstanding collaboration with the Association of Legal Administrators—Orange County Chapter.

Through Project SELF, the legal community is making a significant impact on the lives of Santa Ana youth. Interns are introduced to a professional working experience while enhancing their knowledge, skills, and self-esteem.

Interns set their schedule with their employer and typically work 20-30 hours/week. Internships include these exciting opportunities:

- Access to paid, professional work enviornments.
- Career exploration within the legal field
- Meaningful relationships with professional mentors reinforcing the ethics of hard work, responsibility, and task completion.
- Hands-on training in the areas of resume development, professional conduct and dress, interviewing, basic office skills, and business communications.
- The Mid-Summer Education Day, a one-day event where interns tour the Court of Appeals; attend mock traffic courts, drug courts, and a felony trial; and explore scholarship and employment opportunities.
- Recognition dinner at the conclusion of the eight-week internship, to recognize the interns' accomplishments.
